Summer Autism Program for Ages 5 to 17

The Brunswick Day Program is an Intensive Outpatient Program for children and teens with high-functioning autism. The day program runs from June 10 through July 12 and is designed for elementary, middle and high school students. Students must have completed kindergarten.

- Held Monday through Friday (except July 4) from 9 am to 2 pm.
- Students may attend one week or any number of consecutive weeks (for insurance reasons, students must attend consecutive weeks)
- Provides a supportive environment designed for learning.
- Lunch will be provided.

Our pattern-based curriculum can include:

- Social skills development
- Sensory motor integration skills training
- Educational/learning skills
- Study skills/adaptive classroom behavior
- Activity/recreational therapy
